

MKC 2025 CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP POLICY

The MKC Committee has set the following Policy document which outlines The Club Championship Points structure and rules of eligibility for competitors in the 2025 Race Season

Championship Club Name	Mackay and District Kart Club Inc			
Authority	The Meeting will be held under the International Sporting Rules – Mackay & District Kart Club Inc Rules and Addendums issued by the promoters.			
Eligible Championship Rounds	February 2025 – November 2025 9 allocated race meetings falling within the calendar months as above.			
Championship Coordinator	Mackay and District Kart Club Executive Committee or as approved			
Championship Points Coordinator	Mackay and District Kart Club Executive Committee or as approved			
Championship Registration Fee	FREE – For all current licensed MKC club members			
Championship Eligibility	 ELIGIBILITY for Championship trophies at year end is determined as follows: A class must have 3 or MORE competitors race at least 6 or MORE of allocated rounds in the calendar year to be eligible for championship trophies in that specific class at year end. If race events are cancelled, then the required race events will be reduced by the number of cancelled meetings. You must be a financial member of MKC at the time of racing to be awarded championship points for that race meeting. Non - MKC members, will be allocated points based on their placings however these will not count towards the Club Championship. Drivers MUST be a MKC financial member and compete in at least 6 of the 8 Club Championship rounds on offer at MKC as per the Eligible Championship Rounds. If race events are cancelled, then the required race events will be reduced by the number of cancelled meetings. Beginners moving up a class within the championship will not be required to complete the minimum 6 rounds in their new class, however, they are not able to transfer points accumulated from the beginner class to their new class. 			



Requirement to participate at a Working Bee or Volunteer in a race day role to be eligible for championship.	The requirement to participate in either a Working Bee or fulfill a volunteer race day role to be eligible for the Championship is Now under review and will remain so until May 1,2025 where a decision to enact this requirement may be made in accordance with rules IA05948						
Championship Round Dates	February 2025 – November 2025						
Championship Points Table Visibility	The Club Championship points table will be updated and issued regularly by MKC Committee. The Championship points table will be locked down October 1 st 2025 with the winners to be revealed at the 2025 Presentations.						
Championship Point Scoring System	 Club Championship to be run over 9 rounds from February 2025 to November 2025. 						
	 In the event a race meeting is rained out & cannot be completed on another date within the February 2025 to November 2025 period – ZERO points will be allocated for that meeting. 						
	 Points will be calculated to a total of 200 possible points achievable per round, based on driver placings in each race. All heats and finals count towards point. 						
	Drop Round - The lowest scoring round or a Zero-Point Round will be dropped for each driver at the end of the year. This in effect considers 8 rounds in the determination of the club championship.						
	 "Zero Point Round" is defined as where a driver is absent from the event. If a driver is disqualified from any round, the disqualified round may NOT be used as a dropped round.

	DNF (Did Not Finish) will receive the equivalent points of the field plus one.				
	DSQ (Disqualified) will result in 0 points being awarded for that portion of the race or meeting they are disqualified from.				
Scoring of Points	All finishing positions recorded in MyLaps will be deemed the finishing order.				
	 Points will be awarded for each event based on the racers finishing positions. 				
	Every race meeting will have a maximum of 200 points that can be earned at the event.				
	All heat races and finals will attract points.				
	The finishing positions of all racers, including non MKC members, will be considered when allocating points, however only MKC members as per Championship Eligibility will be eligible for the Club Championship.				
	For combined classes it will be finishing place as if the class was not combined.				
Championship Trophies	Championship trophies will be presented to 1 st , 2 nd , 3 rd in each class as per Championship Eligibility.				
Other Details	The championship Policy is to be read in conjunction with the Supplementary Regulations for Each Round of the Club Championship				

Accuracy
