



2017 Mackay Kart Club Championship Rules

The MKC Club Championship is only open to licensed driver with current club membership. It is an opportunity for every racer to earn points throughout the year, with the highest point finishers receiving the coveted title of Club Champion for their class. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd highest placed MKC members will receive Club Championship trophies at our end of year presentation. Club Champions will be posted on the Mackay Kart Club webpage for the following year, and be listed on the Champions Board located at the track as a celebration of their achievements.

All races held in Mackay will be club championship rounds except for the State Championship Round to be held in April. Two rounds of the MKC Championship series will be held in conjunction with Whitsunday Kart Club at their track. Please note you need to nominate at the Whitsunday Kart Club meetings and race to collect championship points towards MKC championship points tally.

Scoring of Points

The point system has been designed to be as simple and as fair as possible.

- ❖ All finishing positions recorded in CM:S will be deemed the finishing order.
- ❖ Points will be awarded for each event based on the racers' finishing positions
- ❖ All Club Championship meetings will have either a "4 races + qualifying" or a "5 races" format, or as determined by the supplementary regulations.
- ❖ All qualifying, heat races, pre-finals and finals will attract a maximum of 20 points each.
- ❖ Every race meeting will have a maximum of 100 points that can be earned at the event.
- ❖ The finishing positions of all racers, including non MKC members, will be taken into account when allocating points, however only MKC members will actually be eligible for the Club Championship.



Points will be awarded as follows:

- ❖ 1st place will earn 20 points
- ❖ 2nd place will earn 18 points
- ❖ 3rd place will earn 17 points and so on down to 19th place, which will earn 1 point. A 20th place or more will receive 0 points.
- ❖ The finishing order for qualifying will attract the same points as races. For example a Pole Position will earn 20 points, a 2nd will earn 18 points and so on
- ❖ A DNS (Did Not Start) will receive 0 points
- ❖ A DNF (Did Not Finish) will receive the equivalent points of the field plus one. For example if there are 8 racers in the field all DNFs will receive points as if they finished in 9th place (11 points).
- ❖ A DQ (Disqualified) will result in 0 points being awarded for that portion of the race or meeting they are disqualified from.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the Club Championship, a racer must compete at a minimum of 4 race meetings of the nominated Mackay Kart Club Championship series listed above.

Accuracy

The CM:S results will be used to determine the points awarded to competitors. It is up to the individual competitors to check the CM:S results after each meeting to ensure it is accurate. Any discrepancies must be communicated to the Club Secretary as soon as is practically possible after the event.

Disputes

The MKC Executive will consider all issues or disputes raised via the Club Secretary, without prejudice. The MKC Executive will be the judge of any dispute relating to the interpretation of the rules or the points awarded and their decision will be final.
